### ROSE WEEK 2011 - OPEN GARDENS

**A Clay & Gwen Matulin- Arumpo Street, Renmark** (past cemetery entrance, see district map) A large country garden with sweeping lawns on all sides and massed plantings of magnificent roses around the house. There is a collection of 450 roses and a collection of fruit trees set in the lawn for home use on one side of the drive. Phone 8595 1961 Gold coin entry.

**B Danny & Donna Hoffmann- Rialto Street, Renmark** (see district map) This garden has good structure with a formal design. A row of burgundy Icebergs features at the front of the house, with a conifer section along southerly side. Good variety of roses and perennials. Phone 8595 1165. Gold coin entry (includes tea & coffee).

**C Malcolm & Lorna Rogers Bookmark Avenue, Renmark** (see district map) This newly established garden is a country cottage garden with a woodland area. Self sown annuals fill the spaces between a colourful medley of cottage perennials, with shrubs to add height. Roses feature as standards, bushes and climbers. Gaura self seeds freely and provides a delicate foil for the brightly coloured roses. Malcolm's creative use of recycled materials to build arches, frames and tripods is an interest to the many visitors to this garden. Phone 8586 6664. Gold coin entry.

**D Darryl & Judy Jones – Ral Ral Avenue, Renmark** between Paroo and Begarra Streets (see district map) This garden combines a good collection of roses and bearded Iris set amongst bulbs, perennials and native trees. Swags of the climbing rose Pierre de Ronsard each side of the front door tone in beautifully with the house. Old vehicles are whimsical feature under a gnarled old gum tree and there is an old shed for entertaining in the back garden that fits in very well with the rustic country look. Cuppa available. **E Greg & Jill Knight-“Wistow” Tapalin Street, Renmark** (see district map) This garden has a very fine collection of roses in well grouped colour schemes set off nicely by well kept spacious lawns on all sides of the home. A good use of climbers trained on horizontal wires against a background of purple leafed Prunus and Cypress. Among the roses are a nicely coordinated mixture of perennials and bulbs and ground covers. Phone 8595 1868 Gold coin entry.

**F Paul & Judy Taylor– Ral Ral Avenue Renmark** (opposite hospital) (see town map) This very well designed garden is set in spacious immaculate lawns bordering a very fine collection of trees, shrubs, bulbs and perennials. There are interesting paths meandering around the perimeter of the garden and a pergola covered by a venerable 65 year old Wisteria. Phone 8586 6574. Gold coin entry.

**G Riverside Estate- 1 Murray Dyer Avenue, Renmark** (see town map) Wander through the water-wise gardens of this beautiful lifestyle estate. Sub-surface irrigation has been used throughout to optimise water efficiency. View the roses and admire the lovely landscaped gardens and surroundings.

**H Alan & Miriam McLean- 30 Meander Avenue, Renmark** (see town map) The roses in the front garden of the town garden are in autumn shades to complement the house. Either side of the driveway is lined with standard “Chicago Peace”. Wander through the side gate passing through the shade house before reaching the back garden. Situated on Nardoo Lagoon makes this garden the perfect spot for outdoor living. The roses in the back garden are in colours of pinks, creams and mauves set amongst perennials, annuals and trees. **I Di Speight- 5 Eleventh Street, Renmark** (see town map) This is a cottage garden with an arch of Lorraine Lee in the front. Di has built many of the structures herself from recycled materials. **J Dean & Judy Evans- 125 Thurk Street, Renmark** (see town map) "Iceberg" and David Austin roses under planted with Bearded Iris "Nestle" behind a picket fence. A recently constructed pergola overlooks the Mediterranean Urn planted with "Ballerina" and "Margery Fair" surrounded by standard "Iceberg" roses completes the formal look. Walk through the patio area to the back garden taking in the water feature and lawn area surrounded by "Red Pixie" roses. Phone 8586 5180 Gold coin entry.

**K Renmark high school – Cnr Eighteenth & Thurk Streets, Renmark** (see town map) Renmark High School boasts five small, but colourful rose gardens. The first was planted in 1999 as a school memorial garden and has a red and white colour theme. One garden is devoted to Gold Bunny and the other three an electric mix of colours and varieties. **L Mr & Mrs Ppiros - 42 Korinthos Street, Renmark** (see town map) A beautiful town garden always outstanding for its colour and form. Weeping roses on stands at the front overlooking smaller plants and climbing roses all the way down the side fence give a wall of colour. Bush roses, pot plants in the back entertainment area and other flowering shrubs make this an award winning, must see garden. Phone 8586 3227. Gold coin entry.

**M Zoe Warner 126 Seventeenth Street, Renmark** (see town map) Original quarter acre town block. This is a semi-formal garden, combining a water feature, hedges and rose-covered arches and arbour. Garden beds of roses and hardy plants, mostly Mediterranean, are repeated throughout. In addition, the backyard plantings include a vegetable patch, small orchard and mature trees, with delightful areas to sit and relax. Gold coin entry.

**N Noel & Colleen Vine Industry Road, Renmark** (see town map) This garden has a good collection of roses set among curved lawn paths. All roses are labelled. There is an archway of 'Pierre de Ronsard' leading to the garden and a tripod of climbing Pinkie. The back garden consists of roses and some native plants. Phone 8586 4573. Gold coin entry.

## LYRUP OPEN GARDENS

**O Sindy & Joe Romeo - 16 Gallery Terrace, Lyrup** Walk through the gorgeous 'Gold Bunny' arch and follow the paths leading you to an unusual sculpture featuring a wedge tail eagle and its nest. The area is planted with white 'Icebergs' and 'Simply Magic' roses. On the left is a water saving, low maintenance Australian themed garden with a dry creek bed, surrounded by appropriate "wildlife". It features a saltbush hedge meandering to the more formal area at the back. A row of ornamental pears with an old wisteria formed into a standard create interest. The look is completed with standard Lilly pillies. The formal backyard is suited to autumn/winter entertaining and features a Japanese box hedge and standard "Big Red" Lilly pillies. **P Marg Tschirpig - 48 Brown Street, Lyrup** This garden is a work in progress with the revamp commenced just over 12 months ago. The front lawn has been edged with a row of Prunus "Oakville Crimson Spire" inter-planted with 'Laurustinus' to form a hedge between the trees to create a sense of privacy. The rustic arch intertwined with white 'Hardenbergia' frames the front entrance and complements the beautiful old stone home. The driveway is bordered by a pink and white themed rose garden, featuring white bush and standard 'Icebergs', standard 'Pinkie', 'Tutu Mauve', 'Seduction' and a border of 'Simply Magic'. The area features two beautiful 'Gleditsia' trees and a border of Agapanthus. A kitchen garden has been established in front of the old rustic shed featuring two standard Bay trees, and a Rosemary hedge. The rest of the garden features lawns, more roses, iris and lavender. **Q Sue & Phil Lloyd - Pike Creek Road, Lyrup** A garden of sprawling lawns and big trees was revamped two years ago due to water restrictions. A low maintenance, water-wise garden extended the outdoor entertaining area with the inclusion of a Balinese hut by the existing pool. The front features 'Simply Magic' and white 'Iceberg' roses under the dappled light of the existing trees and palms. The garden features many "rooms" and the back has a Tuscan feel, ideal for winter entertaining. The pergola is covered with deciduous vine and wisteria. 'Pierre de Ronsard' climbers have been used on the pillars and the fence. Standard white 'Icebergs' and 'Bonica' plus an area of mixed pink bush roses complete the rose theme. Telephone 8583 8208. **R Mary Romeo - Pomeroy Crescent, Lyrup** Revamped approximately 18 months ago, the front border of pink diosma and lavender was retained but due to the water restrictions, the front lawn was replaced with a low maintenance semi-formal garden featuring native grasses. The right side garden is "roses galore" featuring a Pierre de Ronsard swag which is absolutely stunning in flower as it creates a waterfall effect over the fence into the neighbours' Pierre de Ronsard. White standard and bush 'Icebergs', 'Seduction', 'Simply Magic', 'Christian Dior' and 'Tinkerbell' complete the garden theme. A row of flowering ash line one side of the left driveway with a row of mixed hybrid tea roses on the other. Telephone 8583 8206. Gold coin entry
