**A3 RUSTON'S ROSE GARDEN - Moorna Street, via Twenty third Street, Renmark** (see town map). Over a period of 40 years the garden has developed into a collection of over 40,000 bushes with over 4,000 different varieties. The new National Rose Centre of Australia will incorporate the extension of the "David Ruston Rose Centre" and has two principle functions. Firstly, to meet the increasing demand for a function/conference/event facility to cater for up to 150 people and secondly to provide a central repository of interesting, interactive and interpretative information about the rose and it's role in Australian history and culture.
